At the end of the two-year term, a renewal will be sent to you and renewal fees will be required to maintain your certification along with the minimal CECs. Also, if you attend both days of the 15th annual Hawaii Floodplain Management Conference on August 12 - 13, 2019 and if certified, you will earn 10 CEC credits towards your next renewal. A certificate of attendance will be provided to you as verification of participation.

- When an applicant cancels from a scheduled exam, with at least two weeks' notice to the ASFPM Executive Office, he/she may receive a 50% refund. No refund will be given if the cancellation occurs with less than two weeks' notice. An exam may be rescheduled within 1 year.
