

A Step-by-Step Guide for Creating Annotated Effective and Historic FIRMettes



Step 1: Navigate to FEMA's Map Service Center at www.msc.fema.gov and search for desired address.




Enter an address or place of interest





panel.








Open the "FIRM Panels" folder and search for the similar map panel number (numeric portion only) as the Effective FIRMette.



- Microsoft Office: Word, Publisher


- Adobe: Photoshop, Acrobat Professional

Annotating the FIRMettes

Step 11: Use the features of the editing software to add a text box that identifies the property owner's name(s), site address, and TMK number. For clarification, additional annotation may be added. Most importantly, the location of the subject structure should be identified on the map by drawing an arrow, pointer, or other marker.






