FEMA sent letter to County offering a Provisionally Accredited Levee (PAL) designation while county conducted a levee analysis for Hanapepe and Waimea River levees.	November 2, 2007
FEMA issued letter to County providing notice for the deaccreditation of Hanapepe and Waimea River levees. Letter acknowledges the receipt of a signed PAL agreement and “provisionally” accredits the levees on the effective FIRM dated November 26, 2010	December 27, 2010
FEMA issued letter to County indicating FIRM revisions ON HOLD - <i>FEMA established a multidisciplinary Project Team with representatives from FEMA, the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), and experts from the academic and engineering communities to: evaluate a spectrum of possible approaches for addressing levees and the base flood, evaluate the approach scenarios, and assess the feasibility and implementation of potential approaches.</i>	June 6, 2011
